

#### **Elections & Installation**

Well, the Election & Installation are here. Pup Tents Office (except those designated in Sec 303) shall be elected and installed for a period of one

year. The Shavetails shall elect and install NLT the last day of March, unless otherwise provided for by special dispensation granted by the Grand Commander. District or Area Pup Tents (IAW Sec 404D) will follow the same rules as noted in the Grand Bylaws, unless otherwise directed by special dispensation. If you have adopted procedures that allow for virtual attendance, I encourage you to review your guidelines prior to the Scratch.

#### Delegates

As per Sec.326 of the Supreme Bylaws; delegates to the Grand Scratch are based on the strength of its monthly report for the period prior to the Grand Scratch, provided that the members elected hold a paid-up a dues card and the Pup Tent has paid per capita tax during the month prior to the Grand Scratch.

Pup Tents within the Grand Tent, who are in arrears for membership reports, minutes, CCDB returns, per capita tax payments, and inspection reports will be excluded from all representation in the Grand and Supreme Scratches until reviewed by proper authority.

Calculate the number of authorized delegates by dividing the number of members in good standing by 15 or a fraction thereof, equals your Pup Tent delegate strength. Example: 50/15 = 3.33 or 4 authorized delegates

#### **Amendments and Resolutions**

If anyone has a proposed Amendment to our Grand Bylaws or Supreme Bylaws, you are asked to run them through the proper channels and submit them in final format to me Not Later Than the 15th of May 2023. ### 6 Body Parts You Should Not Ignore After 50

#### 1. Your eyes

Even if you have perfect vision, an eye exam every one to three years should be part of your routine starting at age 55, when the eye begins to blur and lose central vision, which damages the optic nerve, threatening peripheral vision. Some researches show you can slow the progress of macular degeneration with a specific multivitamin supplement. And if you're experiencing the gritty sensation of dry eye — which gets more common with age — look for relief with omega-3-rich foods or supplements, eyelid hygiene or artificial tears.

#### 2. Your teeth and gums

These days, basic oral hygiene can get the needed mileage out of them but, you may need to do more than you are used to. To keep your teeth and gums healthy for the long haul, it's recommends doubling down on your oral hygiene (no skipping flossing tonight!). And avoid chewing ice, as tooth enamel can chip, or using your teeth for things like removing a price tag. "Teeth are not tools," he says.





#### 3. Your feet

You probably don't think much about your feet until they hurt — and pain is a strong likelihood. Many of my patients over 50 have significant foot issues, Long-term forces are often to blame. Calluses on the soles develop from foot abnormalities that make it difficult to walk, such problems not only make your feet smart but can lead to knee, hip and back problems.

Forty to 60 are the prime ages for inflammation of the tissue band (fascia) that connects the heel bone to the toes. It typically comes from overstressing the fascia due to the force of activity and hard surfaces. Feet are designed for grass, dirt and sand; so, everything that we walk on is hard, and it's the hard stuff that causes problems. What to do: Wear supportive shoes — even around the house.

#### 4. Your pelvic floor

You might think of the pelvic floor — the muscles that stretch from the pubic bone back to the tailbone at the bottom of the pelvis — as a female concern. But it's just as important to men. The pelvic floor muscles hold up your bowel, your bladder, and your uterus, if you're a woman, and your prostate, if you're a man. A strong pelvic floor is also essential to sexual arousal. Strengthening your body's core is also vital. Abdominal muscles, hip muscles and spinal muscles connect to and support the pelvic floor, and vice versa, allowing it to work at its best.

#### 5. Your hips and knees

These familiar joints are among your body's most vulnerable. They are considered weight-bearing joints. And having a knee or a hip that is causing you pain diminishes every aspect of your life." Unfortunately, hip and knee pain are common after 50 and often lead to surgery. Other factors like obesity can also play a role. The carrying extra weight seems to wear out, not just because there's more stress, but having a lot of fatty tissue on your body causes you inflammation, and that inflammation seems to attack hip and knees. Shedding excess pounds and exercising are good ways to minimize joint pain. If your joint is already giving you trouble, keep moving, but you may need to alter what you've been doing. So, listen to your joints.

#### 6. Your ears

LISTEN UP ---- Just 2 percent of Americans ages 45 to 54 have serious hearing loss. But that changes over time, rising to half of people 75 and older. We start to see people who are bothered by hearing loss in their 50s and 60s. Hearing changes may be small year to year, and it takes the average person seven years to seek help, but addressing hearing loss early on may lead to I lowering risks for depression and dementia, both of which can be linked to poor hearing. Another reason to care for your ears: They play a crucial role in preserving your balance and preventing falls, which become more common and risky as you age.

We have selected the Temple Mission Palms Hotel and Conference Center, located at 60 East 5th street in Tempe, AZ. The room rate is \$119.00 plus tax and a reduced resort fee of \$5.95 per day. The room rate is for 2 people in the room if you put 3 or 4 people in the room the rate goes up \$10.00 for each person. The hotel is pet friendly, for certified service dogs at no charge. The hotel will allow family pets at a one-time fee of \$25.00. I have arranged for a breakfast buffet at a cost of \$12.00 for your time at the hotel Sunday through Sunday. The hotel has numerous restaurants within easy walking distance of the hotel. There is a shuttle, to and from the airport that runs twice an hour and is available to take you anywhere want within a 3-mile radius of the hotel, which could take you to several local restaurants. There is also a light rail system that will take you to the convention center if you want to attend the VFW convention. I have been told that the cost of the light rail system is \$2.00 per day.
