

Rules of Order for the June 2021 CofA Grand Scratch will be in Straight Talk!!!

"Rules of Order were sent to the Council" and "I second the motion for them to be accepted."

At this time, in accordance with (IAW) By Laws Section 302, you should have had your Elections (Elective) for Seam Squirrel, Blanket Bum, Hide Gimlet, Custodian of the Crummy Duffel Bag, and three (3) Tightwads.

The Seam Squirrel-Elect may appoint IAW Section 303, Sky Pilot, Provost Marshal, Jimmy Legs, Keeper of the Lousy Records, Shyster, Pill Pusher, and Hungry Cootie. Seamy may also appoint Hospital Chairperson, Newshound, Wind-Jammer (Bugler) National Home Chairperson, and Life Membership Chairperson and if deemed necessary an assistance CCDB.



Section 304. Election & Installation of Officers.

- A. The Pup Tent Officers shall be nominated, elected, and installed in office for a period of one year. The installation shall be conducted by a member in good standing who holds or has head a rank at least as high as that of Pup Tent Seam Squirrel.
- B. Shavetails shall be elected and installed between the fifteen (15th) day of January and the last day of March, unless otherwise provided for by special dispensation granted by the Grand Commander concerned. The Shavetails thus elected or appointed, and subsequently installed, shall assume the duties of their respective offices immediately upon the installation of the Grand Commander at the conclusion of the Grand Scratch. Pup Tents Officers not within a Grand shall assume the duties of their respective office July 1st.
- C. Before conducting any installation, the installing officer shall publicly verify proof of Quartermaster bonding, inspection report and remittance of Per Capita Tax for the current term.

Section 305, Term of Office.

All officers shall be elected for one year except Trustees (Tight Wads). Tight Wads shall be elected when the Pup Tent is first instituted; one (1) to serve year, one (1) to serve two years, and one (1) to serve three years shall be held. In the event a vacancy occurs in any one of the Trustee positions, an election to fill the vacancy will be for the position vacated (i.e., 1 year, 2 year, 3 year).

Section 306, Officers - Balloting For.

When balloting for Officers, a majority of all votes cast, except where otherwise designated, shall be necessary for a choice. If there is no election on the first two ballots, the name of the candidate receiving the lowest number of ballots shall be dropped and so on in successive ballots until an election is made.

Seam Squirrel-Elects, please look to appoint your Inspectors to assist the incoming Councilmembers and Grand Inspector to get off to a smooth start of the year.

Comrades and Coots of the Pacific,

At the VFW National Convention this past July our National Home Chairmen Randall Himes and I did some more research on the Pacific sponsoring a House at the National Home. We found out that at the Home there are 2 Duplex's and that one or two of the individual homes would be available for sponsorship. So, we investigated more and found out that it only cost \$4,000.00 a year for a sponsorship of half of a duplex. I said where do we sign up!

They told us we were number one on the list for a half of a duplex. Well after months of perseverance we were notified last night that the Air National Guard House sponsored by Florida was available. I immediately called the National Home.

After coordinating with Sue Alverson at the Home. We agreed that I would sign responsibility and sponsorship of the home effective 1 January 2017. This would give us time to raise the first \$4,000.00 for this. Since it was in the donation contract of the person donating the construction of this house that it would always be call the Air National Guard House. However, in our mines it will be the "Pacific House." Just remember on the plaque on the house it will say the Air National Guard House sponsored by the VFW & MOC of the Pacific. In order to raise continuous moneys to pay for the Maintenance and Utility Bills of this House \$4,000.00 per year. We have derived the following program and of course we would always be opened to any and all donations.

Membership into the Pacific House will cost \$45.00. With this donation the members would receive a Certificate and a

Pacific House Pin along with a tab attached with the year. As seen on the next page.


